



CHAPTER 85

An Act respecting certain corporations subsidized by
the Province

[Assented to, the 20th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative As-
sembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Respecting any secular corporation administer-
ing a hospital and having received or receiving, under Holding of
certain in-
quiries. any form whatsoever, a subsidy or grant from the
Government of the Province, the Lieutenant-Governor
in Council may decree the conducting by one or more
persons whom he designates, in the manner and with
the formalities and powers that he enacts, of any
inquiry into the way the public moneys paid to such
corporation have been, are or will be expended.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into
force. sanction.
