



CHAPTER 86

An Act to amend the Foundlings' Act

[Assented to, the 20th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 3 of the Foundlings' Act (Revised R. S., c. 194, Statutes, 1925, chapter 194) is amended by replacing the words: "by the terms of which", in the sixth and seventh lines thereof, by the word: ", and".

2. The said act is amended by adding thereto, ^{Id., s. 7,} after section 6 thereof, the following section: ^{added.}

"**7.** *La Crèche St-Vincent de Paul*, incorporated by Rights, etc., the act 14 George V, chapter 121, has and has always ^{of La Crèche} had, prior to and since its incorporation, the rights and ^{St-Vincent} powers mentioned in sections 3, 4 and 5 of this act." ^{de Paul}
