



CHAPTER 87

An Act to recognize the independance of religious institutions

[Assented to, the 17th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The provisions of every general law or special ^{Provisions} act, which oblige a religious institution to transmit to ^{repealed.} the Lieutenant-Governor in Council or to the Provincial Secretary a statement of the property held by it or the names of its officers or a copy of its by-laws, are repealed.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
