



CHAPTER 94

An Act to amend the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1931

[Assented to, the 20th of May, 1937]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 52 of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 21 Geo. V, c.
1931, (21 George V, chapter 100), is amended: 100, s. 52,

ants, inspectors, medical experts, other officers, clerks and employees, as he may deem necessary for the carrying out of this act, prescribe their duties and fix their salaries.”

Application of ss. 1 and 2. **3.** The provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this act shall apply to the members and to the present staff of the Quebec Workmen's Compensation Commission.

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
