



## CHAPTER 99

### An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting dogs at large

*[Assented to, the 14th of April, 1937]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** Article 406 of the Municipal Code is amended by M. C., art. adding thereto, after the word: "municipality", in the <sup>406, am.</sup> last line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: "; to authorize any officer appointed for such purpose to destroy any unmuzzled dog at large and considered dangerous by such officer". <sup>Destroying unmuzzled dogs.</sup>
- 2.** The above powers are likewise granted to the county councils for the unorganized territory which comes under the jurisdiction of such councils. <sup>Unorganized territory.</sup>
- 3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. <sup>Coming into force.</sup>
