



## CHAPTER 110

An Act to amend the Act 24 George V, chapter 101

*[Assented to, the 20th of May, 1937]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Section 2 of the act 24 George V, chapter 101, <sup>24 Geo. V, c. 101, s. 2, am.</sup> is amended by replacing the second paragraph of section 488 of the Cities and Towns' Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 102), as replaced, for the town of Laval-des-Rapides, by the said section 2 of the act 24 George V, chapter 101, by the following paragraph:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of section 522, no <sup>Fixed valuation of certain immoveables.</sup> immoveable used for agricultural purposes in the municipality shall be valued at more than one hundred dollars per arpent. Such valuation shall include the barns, stables and all other buildings, but shall not include the house used as a residence, which shall be valued separately, taking into account only its value in regard to the adjoining agricultural exploitation."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the 1st of January, 1938. <sup>Coming into force.</sup>
