



CHAPTER 129

An Act to amend the charter of the Montreal Police Benevolent and Pension Society

[Assented to, the 20th of May, 1937]

WHEREAS a certain category of members, consisting of veteran policemen now retired, of the Montreal Police Benevolent and Pension Society, incorporated by the act 55-56 Victoria, chapter 90, amended by the act 25-26 George V, chapter 161, has, by its petition, represented that the said act no longer meets its requirements and that it is expedient to amend the same in order to permit the Society to attain the object for which it was formed; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 7 of the act 55-56 Victoria, chapter 90, ^{55-56 Vict.,} as replaced by the act 25-26 George V, chapter 161, ^{c. 90, s. 7,} section 4, is amended by adding to paragraph *k* thereof ^{am.} the following words: "This paragraph shall not apply to persons superannuated before the 6th of September, 1935."

2. Section 11 of the act 55-56 Victoria, chapter 90, ^{Id., s. 11,} re- as replaced by the act 25-26 George V, chapter 161, ^{placed.} section 7, is again replaced by the following:

"11. The affairs of the society shall be carried on ^{Board of} and administered by a board of directors composed of ^{directors.}

eight members, of whom six shall be elected at the annual general meeting and another appointed each year, prior to the said annual general meeting, by the "*Association des vétérans policiers incorporée*". At the same meeting the *Association des vétérans policiers* shall appoint a substitute who shall be entitled to sit on the board of directors, in the case of the absence, inability to act or death of the representative appointed; but, until the general meeting in the month of February, 1938, the affairs of the society shall be carried on and administered by the members forming the present board of directors as elected at the meeting in the month of February, 1937."

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
