



## CHAPTER 4

An Act to establish the inventory of the natural resources of the Province

[Assented to, the 12th of November, 1936]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to make an inventory Preamble.  
of the natural resources of the Province, so as :

1. To establish the value of same and be cognizant of the advantages thereof available for the activities of our population;
2. To supervise more closely the development of our riches, to direct with better knowledge industrial and agricultural production, and to assure the rational working of our timber, minerals, fisheries and water-powers;
3. To adapt industry, big or small, to the resources and particular needs of each region;
4. To procure work for our youth, to open careers for them and utilize their talents and energies.

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** The Government of the Province is authorized to proceed to make an inventory of our natural resources, and, for such purpose, an amount of one hundred thousand dollars is placed at its disposal. Inventory of natural resources.

**2.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may appoint the technicians, specialists, advisers, officers and employees whose services may be useful for the carrying out of this act. Appointing of technicians, etc., therefor.

Carrying out of act. **3.** The Minister of Municipal Affairs, Trade and Commerce shall have charge of the carrying out of this act.

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
