



## CHAPTER 6

An Act respecting the printing of the reports of the departments of the public administration

*[Assented to, the 12th of November, 1936]*

**W**HEREAS the printing for the Legislature of the Preamble.  
reports and returns of certain departments of the public administration and of certain public functionaries occasions to the Province considerable expenditure ;

Whereas it is expedient, for purposes of economy, to abolish such practice, in order to devote to pressing needs all available public monies;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** From and after the 7th of October, 1936, notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no report or return of any department of the public administration or of any public functionary shall be printed or introduced before the Legislature, saving such reports or returns, contemplated by laws now in force, as the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may order to be printed and introduced. Printing, etc., of reports, etc., conditional upon order

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
