



CHAPTER 14

An Act respecting the Quebec Liquor Commission

[Assented to, the 12th of November, 1936]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The exercise of the functions, duties and powers ^{Vesting of functions, etc., of Q. L.} of the Quebec Liquor Commission shall be vested in one person alone, named by the Lieutenant-Governor ^{person.} C., in one in Council, with the title of manager. The remuneration of such person shall be determined by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council and be paid out of the revenues of the Liquor Commission.

2. The officers, inspectors, clerks and other employees of the Quebec Liquor Commission shall be ^{Appointing, etc., of officers, etc.} appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council who shall fix their salary or remuneration, assign to them their official functions and titles and define their respective duties and powers. Their salary or remuneration shall be paid out of the revenues of the Liquor Commission.

3. The manager and every person appointed to any employment for the Quebec Liquor Commission shall, if, on his entry into office, required thereto ^{Giving of security by guarantee policy.} by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, give security, in conformity with sections 12 to 39 of the Public Officers Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 9), by a guarantee policy for the amount fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

Restriction
as to certain
suits.

4. No one appointed under this act as manager of the Quebec Liquor Commission may be sued, for acts done or omitted to be done by him in the exercise of the duties vested in him under this act, except by the Government of this Province, or with the authorization of the Chief Justice of the Province or, if he be prevented from granting such authorization, by the senior judge of the Court of Appeal.

Provisions
repealed, etc.

5. The provisions of the Alcoholic Liquor Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 37), and its amendments, in so far as personally concerns the members of the Quebec Liquor Commission, are amended or repealed accordingly.

Coming into
force.

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
