



## CHAPTER 16

### An Act to amend the Alcoholic Liquor Act respecting the certificate of analysis

[Assented to, the 12th of November, 1936]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 116 of the Alcoholic Liquor Act (Revised R. S., c. 37, Statutes, 1925, chapter 37), as amended by the act s. 116, am. 24 George V, chapter 17, section 26, is again amended by replacing the second paragraph thereof by the following:

"In any proceeding instituted under this act, the certificate relating to the analysis of any liquor, and signed by the analyst of the Commission, shall be accepted as proof, *prima facie*, of the facts set forth therein and of the authority of the person giving or issuing such certificate, without further evidence of his appointment or of his signature. The cost of such latter analysis shall also be included in the taxed costs of the case."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. <sup>Coming into force.</sup>
