



## CHAPTER 28

### An Act to amend the Stationary Enginemen's Act

*[Assented to, the 12th of November, 1936]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Section 3 of the Stationary Enginemen's Act R. S., c. 184, (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 184), as amended by <sup>s. 3, replaced.</sup> the act 16 George V, chapter 14, section 54, is replaced by the following:

**"3.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may Appointing  
appoint examiners, not more than three in number, a <sup>of examiners,</sup>  
secretary and the employees deemed necessary for the <sup>etc.</sup>  
carrying out of this act and may fix their salaries in  
accordance with the Outside Service Act (Chap. 10A).

The salaries of the examiners, the secretary and the <sup>Salaries, etc.</sup>  
employees and the travelling and administrative expen-  
ses shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue  
fund of the Province."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup>  
sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
