



CHAPTER 42

An Act respecting the payment of costs upon the
revocation or replacing of attorneys

[Assented to, the 12th of November, 1936]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 264 of the Code of Civil Procedure is C. C. P., art.
amended by adding thereto the following paragraph : 264, am.

“ Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding Revoking,
paragraph, the Crown, whether represented by the etc., of
Attorney-General or another minister, may revoke powers of

such attorney by another, without being obliged to Crown.
