



## CHAPTER 42

An Act respecting the payment of costs upon the revocation or replacing of attorneys

[Assented to, the 12th of November, 1936]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Article 264 of the Code of Civil Procedure is C. C. P., art. amended by adding thereto the following paragraph :<sup>264, am.</sup>

“ Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, the Crown, whether represented by the Attorney-General or another minister, may revoke the powers of an attorney of the Crown, or replace such attorney by another, without being obliged to previously pay the former his fees and disbursements.”

**2.** This act shall apply to pending cases.
