



## CHAPTER 45

An Act to permit the city of Montreal to decree a method of identification for the municipal elections

[Assented to, the 12th of November, 1936]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** The city of Montreal may, by a resolution of its council upon the report of the executive committee:

*a.* Decree that, at the municipal elections, persons not residing in the city of Montreal, and those who reside therein but who are entitled to vote in more than one ward, shall not exercise their right to vote without being identified;

*b.* Order the sending to such interested parties of a registered notice to be used as identification, or adopt any other system for the same purpose;

*c.* Render liable to the penalties and arrest provided for corrupt practices by articles 240 and 241 of the act 62 Victoria, chapter 58, anyone who presents himself at a polling-station with an identification card or other means of identification which is not his own or who prints or causes to be printed, without the authorization of the city, for the purposes of using or distributing the same, or distributes or causes to be distributed any cards or other means of identification imitating those which the said city issues under any resolution adopted in virtue of this act, or who has illegally in his possession any such card or means of identification.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
