



## CHAPTER 2

An Act respecting the extension of a collective labour agreement ratified by order-in-council No. 1729

*[Assented to, the 10th of June, 1936]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Notwithstanding any law or judicial decision, the order-in-council No. 1729 of the 27th of June, 1935, ratifying the collective labour agreement respecting the bakery industry, as amended by the orders-in-council Nos. 2595, 3501 and 769, of the 11th of September, 1935, the 18th of December, 1935, and the 11th of March, 1936, respectively, has always been and shall be binding upon all the employers and employees of the said bakery industry until the 31st of December, 1936, unless the Lieutenant-Governor in Council decides otherwise under the authority of section 5 of the Collective Labour Agreements Extension Act (24 George V, chapter 56). Binding effect of certain order-in-council.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
