



## CHAPTER 20

### An Act to amend the Act to incorporate *Les Sœurs Missionnaires de l'Immaculée Conception*

[Assented to, the 10th of June, 1936]

**W**HEREAS *Les Sœurs Missionnaires de l'Immaculée Conception*, duly incorporated under the act 7 Edward VII (1907), chapter 134, have, by their petition, represented:

That it is in the interest of the said corporation and necessary for the proper administration of its affairs that its corporate powers be extended;

Whereas the said corporation has prayed that the said act 7 Edward VII, chapter 134, be amended for such purpose and it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 2 of the act 7 Edward VII, chapter 134, is replaced by the following:

**"2.** Under such name the corporation shall have perpetual succession, and may;

(a) Appear before the courts;  
(b) Have a seal which it may change or renew whenever it deems advisable;

(c) Acquire, receive and possess moveable and immoveable property of any kind whatsoever, hypothecate, sell, lease or otherwise alienate the same, and acquire others in lieu thereof; the value of the said immoveables shall not exceed one million, eight hundred thousand dollars;

(d) Adopt by-laws and rules for the management of the community, the management of the corporation and the administration of its property."

**2.** The said act is amended by inserting therein, after section 7 thereof, the following section:

Validation  
of certain  
transac-  
tions, etc.

**"7a.** All transactions, all deeds of purchase and all other deeds made up to the 10th of June, 1936, by the said corporation, respecting its moveable and immoveable property, are ratified and validated for all legal purposes, in so far as the value of the immoveables of the corporation might have exceeded the limit fixed by this act, 7 Edward VII, chapter 134."

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
