



CHAPTER 25

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit John McLean Chamard among its members

[Assented to, the 10th of June, 1936]

WHEREAS John McLean Chamard, of the city of Montreal, Province of Quebec, has, by his petition, represented:

That, after a course in classical studies at the University of Saskatchewan, Saskatoon, he entered McGill University in the year 1931, where he studied for four years in the faculty of medicine and dentistry, and received the degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery from the said McGill University;

That he has not undergone the examinations of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, for admission to study, for the profession of Doctor of Dental Surgery;

That, on the 11th day of March, 1935, at a regular meeting, the Provincial Board of Dental Surgery of the Province of Quebec passed a resolution authorizing him to present a private bill to the Legislature, to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit him as one of its members, conditionally upon his passing the final examinations to obtain the license to practise; and

Whereas the said John McLean Chamard has prayed for the passing of an act for such purpose and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said John McLean Chamard among its members from the date of his passing the final examinations to obtain the license to practise.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
