



CHAPTER 26

An Act respecting the adoption of Mariette and Jeannine Limoges Marier

[Assented to, the 10th of June, 1936]

WHEREAS Elphège Marier, advocate, and his wife, Dame Ernestine Durocher, of the town of Pointe Claire, Province of Quebec, have, by their petition, represented: Preamble.

That, on the 16th of October, 1918, they adopted Mariette Limoges, then of the age of two years and a half, and Jeannine Limoges, then thirteen months old; that they brought them up as their daughters and provided for their subsistence and education, and that, under the circumstances, they pray for the passing of an act to validate the adoption of the said Mariette and Jeannine Limoges, and enacting that they be considered as the adopted daughters of the said Elphège Marier and Ernestine Durocher;

Whereas the mother of the said Mariette and Jeannine Limoges, who was a sister of the petitioner, Ernestine Durocher, died on the 18th of October, 1918, and their father, Hector Limoges, accountant, of the city and district of Montreal, has acquiesced in this petition; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The adoption of Mariette and Jeannine Limoges by Elphège Marier and Ernestine Durocher, his wife, on the 16th of October, 1918, is legalized from and after that date, and the said Mariette and Jeannine Limoges shall be deemed to be the adopted daughters of the said Elphège Marier and Ernestine Durocher, enjoying from that date Legalization of adoption of Mariette and Jeannine Limoges.

all the rights and privileges granted by the Adoption Act, Revised Statutes of Quebec, 1925, chapter 196, and its amendments, with the right to add to their name, the name of the family of the adopter, Elphège Marier, and to be legally described under the name of Mariette Limoges Marier and Jeannine Limoges Marier.

Provisions
applicable.

2. The provisions of sections 25 and 26 of the said Adoption Act, referred to above, shall likewise apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to this act, as if a judgment of adoption was in question, as mentioned in the said sections.

Coming into
force.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
