



## CHAPTER 6

### An Act respecting the granting of a subsidy to the town of Terrebonne

[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to supply monies to the town of Terrebonne, in order to aid the latter to pay the interest on the loans contracted by it under the act 13 George V, chapter 7, as amended by the acts 15 George V, chapter 7; 16 George V, chapter 4, and 21 George V, chapter 13, and to provide for the reimbursement of such loans; and

Whereas it appears from the above-cited act that the said loans were authorized for a philanthropic purpose, that of affording aid to the fire-victims of the said town of Terrebonne which was largely destroyed by fire on the 1st of December, 1922;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, on the terms and conditions to be determined by him, grant to the town of Terrebonne, for a period not exceeding five years, a subsidy, payable in annual instalments of five thousand dollars each, out of the consolidated revenue fund, for the purpose of aiding the said town to pay the interest on the loans authorized by the aforesaid act 13 George V, chapter 7, as amended by the acts 15 George V, chapter 7; 16 George V, chapter 4, and 21 George V, chapter 13, and also to provide for the reimbursement of the said loans.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
