



## CHAPTER 9

An Act to grant certain powers to municipal corporations  
to aid the unemployed

*[Assented to, the 18th of May, 1935]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary of any general law or special act, every municipal corporation howsoever incorporated and whatever be the law governing it, whether any agreement or agreements exist or not between the Government of the Dominion and that of this Province, or whether it has or has not received relief from the Government of the Dominion or from the Government of this Province, is authorized to assist the unemployed living in its territory, and, for such purpose, to contribute out of its monies to such extent as it may deem necessary, either out of its general funds, or by means of loans which it may authorize by by-laws and which it may effect by the issuing of bonds or debentures or otherwise, for a period not exceeding thirty years and at a rate of interest not exceeding five per cent per annum, without preliminary or subsequent formality other than the approval of such by-laws by the majority of the members of its council present forming a quorum, by the Quebec Municipal Commission and by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

With the approval of the Quebec Municipal Commission, every such municipal corporation may effect the temporary loans authorized by law, which loans may be renewed with the same approval, provided that such temporary loans be repayable with the proceeds of the sale of the said bonds or debentures, the issuing whereof authorized by the loan by-laws.

The borrowing power granted by this section shall not affect the borrowing power possessed by such municipal corporation, and shall be interpreted as authorizing a loan or loans exceeding the limit fixed by the laws which govern such corporation.

Coming into

**2.** This act shall be in force as from the 1st of April, 1935, up to the 1st of June, 1936.
