



## CHAPTER 14

An Act to amend the Treasury Department Act, respecting  
judicial and other deposits

*[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Treasury Department Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 20,  
1925, chapter 20) is amended by adding thereto, after <sup>s. 65a,</sup> section 65 thereof, the following section:  
<sup>added.</sup>

**“65a.** Monies deposited under Division VII of this act, <sup>Disposal of</sup> or under any other provisions prior thereto to the same <sup>unclaimed</sup> effect, which have not been claimed within a period of thirty <sup>monies.</sup> years from the date of their receipt, shall be paid into the consolidated revenue fund to form part thereof.

Nevertheless, any persons who may be entitled to the <sup>Retaining of</sup> delivery of such monies shall retain such right and may <sup>right.</sup> at any time, upon establishing their claim, exact such delivery.

If payment has to be made of any portion of the monies <sup>If payment</sup> paid into the consolidated revenue fund under this section, <sup>has to be</sup> the Provincial Treasurer is authorized to make such pay- <sup>made.</sup> ment out of the said fund.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
