



CHAPTER 21

An Act to increase, in favour of the settler, the area of land upon which no timber-limit holder may cut timber on a colonization lot

[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 28 of the Lands and Forests Act (Revised R. S., c. 44, Statutes, 1925, chapter 44), as amended by the act 16 s. 28, am. George V, chapter 23, section 1, is again amended by replacing the word: "eight", in the seventh line of the fourth paragraph thereof, by the word: "twenty".

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
