



CHAPTER 21

An Act to increase, in favour of the settler, the area of land upon which no timber-limit holder may cut timber on a colonization lot

[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 28 of the Lands and Forests Act (Revised R. S., c. 44, Statutes, 1925, chapter 44), as amended by the act 16^{s. 28, am.} George V, chapter 23, section 1, is again amended by replacing the word: "eight", in the seventh line of the fourth paragraph thereof, by the word: "twenty".

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. _{force.}
