



## CHAPTER 33

### An Act to amend the Plant Protection Act

*[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 8 of the Plant Protection Act (Revised R. S., c. 72, Statutes, 1925, chapter 72, as replaced by the act 19<sup>s. 8, am.</sup> George V, chapter 25, section 1), is amended by adding thereto, after the word: "year", in the thirteenth line thereof, the words: ", unless sooner cancelled by the entomologist".

**2.** Section 10 of the said act is amended by replacing Id., s. 10, the words: "attacked or deemed to be attacked by destructive insects or plant diseases", in the fourth, fifth and sixth lines thereof, by the words: "which he deems to be attacked by destructive insects, or to suffer from any plant disease or any defect predisposing it to disease".

**3.** Section 17 of the said act is amended: Id., s. 17,

*a.* By replacing the words: "; the vendor shall incur the loss of such products and every purchaser who accepts products without such copy of certificate does so at his own risk", in the tenth, eleventh and twelfth lines thereof, by the words: ", the vendor suffering the loss of such products";

*b.* By adding thereto the following paragraph:

"Every plant or plant product transported, held, offered for sale, sold or delivered, contrary to this act or to the regulations adopted under the authority thereof, may be seized or confiscated by the entomologist, the vendor suffering the loss of such product." <sup>Seizing, etc., of certain plants, etc.</sup>

**4.** Section 21 of the said act is replaced by the following:

**"21.** The entomologist may, with the special authorization of the Minister in every case, cancel or refuse to issue or to renew any permit or certificate contemplated by this act, for any cause deemed sufficient by the Minister."

**5.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
