



## CHAPTER 34

An Act to amend the Colonization, Game and Fisheries Act

[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 3 of the Colonization, Game and Fisheries Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 74) is amended by inserting therein, after the word: "colonization," in the first line of paragraph 1 thereof, the words: "the classification and";

**2.** Section 13 of the said act, as amended by the act of George V, chapter 19, section 8, is replaced by the following:

**13.** The Minister, or the officers of the Department of Colonization whom he may delegate for such purpose, and every person accompanying them, may enter upon and investigate any private property, with a view to making a classification of such property, if necessary to do so for purposes of colonization, but the owner or owners must be indemnified when material damage has been caused to him or them thereby."

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
