



CHAPTER 42

An Act to amend the Quebec Fisheries Act respecting the right of passage in favour of lessees of a fishing reserve

[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 12 of the Quebec Fisheries Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 83) is replaced by the following: R. S., c. 83, s. 12, replaced.

"12. The lessee of a fishing reserve, who has no means of issue to the public highway, may exact a passage over the neighbouring lands, subject to an indemnity proportionate to the damage which he may cause. Such passage must ordinarily be taken on the side where the distance is the shortest from the said reserve to the public highway and the least damageable. Passage by lessee of fishing reserve.

If the parties cannot agree upon the place where such passage must be established or upon the indemnity to be paid, the whole shall be decided in conformity with the provisions of the last paragraph of section 11, as amended by the act 19 George V, chapter 27, section 1." In case of disagreement.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
