



## CHAPTER 51

An Act to amend the Sheep-Owners' Compensation Act

[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 2 of the Sheep-Owners' Compensation Act R. S., c. 123, (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 123) is amended by re- s. 2, am. placing the word: "twenty-five", in the third line of the first paragraph thereof, by the word: "twenty."

**2.** Section 7 of the said act is replaced by the following: Id., s. 7, re- placed.

**"7.** The by-law mentioned in this act shall remain in Duration of force for five years from its adoption, unless the majority by-law. of the subscribers to the petition contemplated in section 2 ask for its cancellation by a petition signed by them and presented to the municipal council. In such latter case, the by-law may be repealed by the municipal council before the expiring of the five years."

**3.** The said act is amended by adding thereto, after R. S., c. 123, section 8 thereof, the following section: s. 9, added.

**"9.** On the failure of the municipal council to pass the Payment by by-law provided for by this act, within the sixty days fol- municipal- lowing the receipt of the petition mentioned in section 2, ity in certain the municipality shall be bound, as long as it shall not case. have passed the said by-law, to pay to the owners or possessors of sheep, out of its ordinary funds, the compensation provided for in paragraph 5 of section 3, provided Proviso. that the claim for compensation be made within the period therein mentioned."

**4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into sanction. force.
