



## CHAPTER 59

An Act to amend Section 115 of the Courts of Justice Act

[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 115 of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised R. S., c. 145, Statutes, 1925, chapter 145) is amended by adding thereto s. 115, am. the following paragraphs:

“Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the fore-<sup>Concurrent</sup>going or in this or any other act, all of the courts of the <sup>jurisdiction</sup>electoral district of Bonaventure shall have concurrent <sup>of court of</sup>jurisdiction with the courts in the electoral districts of <sup>Bonaven-</sup>Gaspé-North, Gaspé-South and the Magdalen Islands. <sup>ture.</sup>”

Such concurrent jurisdiction shall extend to all the offi-<sup>Extent</sup>cers of the courts. <sup>thereof.</sup>

As regards cases in the Magdalen Islands after issue <sup>Certain</sup>joined, when the defendant is domiciled in the Magdalen <sup>cases in</sup>Islands, the record shall be sent to the court in the Magda- <sup>Magdalen</sup>len Islands which alone thereafter shall have jurisdiction <sup>Islands.</sup>to hear the case and to render judgment therein.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup>sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
