



CHAPTER 60

An Act to amend the Courts of Justice Act respecting the payment of the pension of judges of the Sessions of the Peace, police magistrates and district magistrates

[Assented to, the 6th of March, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Courts of Justice Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 145, chapter 145) is amended by adding thereto, after section 241a thereof, as enacted by the act 17 George V, chapter 49, section 1, and amended by the act 20 George, V, chapter 67, section 1, the following:

“**241b.** The pensions contemplated by this subdivision 2 shall be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund.” Payment.

2. Section 248 of the said act, as amended by the act 17 George V, chapter 49, section 2, is again amended by replacing the word and figures: “and 241a”, in the first line thereof, by the word and figures: “, 241a and 241b”. R. S., c. 145, s. 248, am.

3. Section 274 of the said act, as amended by the act 17 George V, chapter 49, section 3, is again amended by replacing the word and figures: “and 241a”, in the first line thereof, by the word and figures: “, 241a and 241b”. Id., s. 274, am.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
