



## CHAPTER 63

### An Act to amend the Industrial and Commercial Establishments Act respecting double gangs

[Assented to, the 18th of May, 1935]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Industrial and Commercial Establishments Act R. S., c. 182, (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 182) is amended by adding <sup>s. 17a,</sup> thereto, after section 17 thereof, the following section: <sup>added.</sup>

“**17a.** Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 15 and 17, the chief inspector may grant a permit authorizing the double gang arrangement in an industrial establishment. In such case, however, the period of work must not exceed eight hours for each gang nor sixteen hours for the two gangs; the distribution of the working hours for the two gangs must be made between six o'clock in the forenoon and eleven o'clock in the evening. <sup>Authorizing of double gang arrangement.</sup>”

In industrial establishments where the double gang operates, the employer must allow, to the employees of both sexes, an hour for the midday meal and an hour for the evening meal; the midday meal must be taken between ten o'clock in the forenoon and noon, and the evening meal between six o'clock and eight o'clock in the evening. <sup>Meal hours in such case.</sup>”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. <sup>Coming into force.</sup>
