



## CHAPTER 69

### An Act to amend the Quebec Pharmacy Act

*[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 32 of the Quebec Pharmacy Act (Revised R. S., c. 215, Statutes, 1925, chapter 215) is replaced by the following: s. 32, replaced.

**"32.** Prosecutions instituted for the recovery of any fine imposed under this act may be instituted by the Association, before a judge of the sessions, police magistrate or recorder, in the cities of Quebec and Montreal, or before a district magistrate or justice of the peace of the place where the offence was committed, in the other parts of the Province, or may be instituted before any court of competent jurisdiction in the place where the offence was committed by civil action in the ordinary manner."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
