



## CHAPTER 74

An Act to amend the Telegraph Companies' Act in order to  
give companies power to extend their lines by building,  
purchase or lease

*[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 9 of the Telegraph Companies Act (Revised R. S., c. 235, Statutes, 1925, chapter 235), as amended by the acts 20 s. 9, am. George V, chapter 89, section 1, and 24 George V, chapter 94, section 2, is again amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"It may also prolong or extend its line, by building or Prolonging,  
by the purchase or lease of an already-established line<sup>etc., of line.</sup>  
beyond the localities, places and roads indicated in its  
letters patent or its memorandum."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into  
sanction. force.
