



## CHAPTER 74

An Act to amend the Telegraph Companies' Act in order to give companies power to extend their lines by building, purchase or lease

*[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 9 of the Telegraph Companies Act (Revised R. S., c. 235, Statutes, 1925, chapter 235), as amended by the acts 20<sup>s. 9, am.</sup> George V, chapter 89, section 1, and 24 George V, chapter 94, section 2, is again amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“It may also prolong or extend its line, by building or <sup>Prolonging,</sup> by the purchase or lease of an already-established line <sup>etc., of line.</sup> beyond the localities, places and roads indicated in its letters patent or its memorandum.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sub>force.</sub>
