



CHAPTER 90

An Act to validate the publication of certain municipal notices

[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The publication of any special or public notice, by law, resolution or ordinance of a municipal council, made before the coming into force of this act, either in the French language or in the English language, when the law required that such publication be made in both languages, may be declared valid and legal by following the formalities herein-after prescribed.

The municipal council may, by resolution, make a petition therefor to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council and the latter, upon a report of the Quebec Municipal Commission to the effect that acquired rights are not affected, may grant the petition of the said municipal council.

The order of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council granting such petition shall have the effect of rendering the publication concerned valid and legal for all legal purposes.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
