



## CHAPTER 94

An Act to amend Article 2161*e* of the Civil Code respecting certain notices to be given to the Attorney-General

*[Assented to, the 6th of March, 1935]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 2161*e* of the Civil Code, as it appears in article C. C., art. 5843 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, and as amended by the <sup>2161*e*, am.</sup> act 5 Edward VII, chapter 30, section 2, is again amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“A similar notice must be sent to the Attorney-General, <sup>Notice to</sup> whether his name is entered in the register of addresses or <sup>Attorney-</sup> not, whenever an immoveable hypothecated to the Crown <sup>General.</sup> for any reason whatsoever is concerned.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup> sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
