



CHAPTER 94

An Act to amend Article 2161e of the Civil Code respecting certain notices to be given to the Attorney-General

[Assented to, the 6th of March, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 2161e of the Civil Code, as it appears in article C. C., art. 5843 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, and as amended by the act 5 Edward VII, chapter 30, section 2, is again amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“A similar notice must be sent to the Attorney-General, whether his name is entered in the register of addresses or not, whenever an immoveable hypothecated to the Crown for any reason whatsoever is concerned.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
