



## CHAPTER 95

An Act to amend Article 2182 of the Civil Code

*[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 2182 of the Civil Code, as replaced by the C. C., art.  
act 12 George V, chapter 91, section 3, is amended by <sup>2182, am.</sup>  
adding thereto the following paragraph:

"No registrar may part with any register, book, docu-  
ment or paper of which he is depositary, nor remove the  
same to afford communication thereof outside of the registry  
office, for any purpose whatsoever, nor may he be required  
to produce the same or any document emanating from his  
office, nor may he be required to produce a copy thereof  
in any court of justice, except in the case of improbation or  
contestation of the authenticity of such documents."

Removing,  
etc., of reg-  
isters, etc.,  
prohibited.

Proviso.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its  
sanction. <sup>Coming into  
force.</sup>
