



CHAPTER 102

An Act to amend Article 697 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 18th of May, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 697 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended C. C. P., art. by the act 1 George V (1910), chapter 42, section 5, is again ^{697, am.} amended by replacing the words and figures: "Paragraphs 10 and 11", in the first and second lines of the first paragraph thereof, by the words and figures: "Paragraphs 9, 10 and 11".

2. The provisions of the foregoing section shall apply to Application. the seizable portion of every salary therein contemplated, falling due after the 1st of May, 1935, even if a seizure by garnishment against such salary has been made before the coming into force of this act and notwithstanding any judgment rendered on such seizure by garnishment.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. _{force.}
