



CHAPTER 106

An Act to amend Article 1222a of the Code of Civil Procedure respecting the transcription of stenographic notes of evidence

[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 1222a of the Code of Civil Procedure, as C. C. P., art. enacted by the act 22 George V, chapter 102, section 1, is ^{1222a, am.} amended by inserting therein, after the word: "death", in the second line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: ", illness or other incapacity".

2. Section 2 of the act 22 George V, chapter 102, is ^{22 Geo. V,} amended: _{c. 102, s. 2, am.}

a. By inserting therein, after the word: "act", in the first line thereof, the words: ", as amended by the act 25-26 George V, chapter 106,";

b. By inserting therein, after the work: "death", in the fourth line thereof, the words: ", illness or other incapacity".

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. _{force.}
