



## CHAPTER 106

An Act to amend Article 1222a of the Code of Civil Procedure respecting the transcription of stenographic notes of evidence

*[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 1222a of the Code of Civil Procedure, as C. C. P., art. enacted by the act 22 George V, chapter 102, section 1, is <sup>1222a, am.</sup> amended by inserting therein, after the word: "death", in the second line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: ", illness or other incapacity".

**2.** Section 2 of the act 22 George V, chapter 102, is <sup>22 Geo. V,</sup> amended: <sub>c. 102, s. 2, am.</sub>

*a.* By inserting therein, after the word: "act", in the first line thereof, the words: ", as amended by the act 25-26 George V, chapter 106,";

*b.* By inserting therein, after the work: "death", in the fourth line thereof, the words: ", illness or other incapacity".

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sub>Coming into force.</sub> sanction.
