



## CHAPTER 107

An Act to replace Article 1354 of the Code of Civil Procedure  
respecting the sale of the property of disqualified  
persons

*[Assented to, the 18th of May, 1935]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 1354 of the Code of Civil Procedure is re- C. C. P., art.  
placed by the following: 1354, re-  
placed.

**"1354.** If no higher price is offered than the upset price, the person applying for the sale may proceed to effect a private sale for a sum not less than the upset price, but he can only do so within the four months which follow the authorization. Effecting of

A judge of the Superior Court having jurisdiction may, however, upon a petition which need not be served, and for reasons deemed valid, extend the above delay for a period not exceeding twelve months starting from the said author- Extension of

tition.

Such petition may be presented by the tutor, the sub- Presenting  
rogate tutor or the curator, as the case may be." of petition.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into
