



## CHAPTER 129

An Act to amend the charter of the town of Louiseville

[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]

**WHEREAS** the town of Louiseville has, by its petition, Preamble.

represented that it is in its interest, and necessary and urgent for the proper administration of its affairs and its future progress that its charter, the act 12 George V, chapter 113, be amended to grant it more extended powers; to ratify and confirm a contract respecting the taxes, the construction of a filter and of a sewer, signed by it and The Textile Company of Canada, Limited, on the 26th of June, 1929, as there are doubts as to the legality of such contract; to fix, at five thousand dollars for five years, for municipal purposes, the valuation of The Empire Shirt Manufacturing Company, Limited, as such valuation has existed for a long time and represents at least twenty-five per cent of the real value; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant its petition and to accord it the powers and privileges prayed for;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The council may make, adopt or repeal by-laws to require a deposit not exceeding two hundred dollars from every person or corporation not residing in the town for twelve months, and desirous of establishing or continuing any business therein. Such deposit must be returned at the expiration of one year from the date on which it was made, if the person or corporation who or which made it is still carrying on the same business. **2.** The contract respecting taxes, the construction of a filter and of a sewer drain, passed before J. A. Ferron, notary, on the 26th day of June, 1929, between the town of Louisville and The Textile Company of Canada, Limited, is ratified and confirmed for the period not to extend beyond the 26th of June, 1939. but the town, notwithstanding this act, may make any contract or agreement to require a higher rent for the filter and to exact a higher tax.

Proviso.

**3.** The valuation of The Empire Shirt Manufacturing Company, Limited, for municipal purposes, is fixed at five thousand dollars for five years to come.

Duration,

**4.** The above-mentioned companies shall have the benefit of the exemptions granted by sections 2 and 3 of this act, as long as they are in operation and continue to employ on an average the same number of workmen as they had in their respective employ during the year 1934.

Coming into

**5.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
