



CHAPTER 137

An Act respecting the municipality of the parish of St. Bernard, county of St. Hyacinthe

[Assented to, the 18th of May, 1935]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The name of “municipality of the south part of the parish of St. Bernard”, situated in the county of St. Hyacinthe, is changed to that of “municipality of the parish of St. Bernard”. “Municipality of the parish of St. Bernard”.

2. The municipality of the parish of St. Bernard, in the county of St. Hyacinthe, comprises the territory bounded as follows: Starting from the point of intersection of the southeast line of St. Pierre concession with the northeast line of the northeast concession of Fleury range; thence, reference being to the official cadastre of the parish of St. Jude, in southeasterly and southwesterly directions, passing successively by the following lines: the northeast line of the northeast concession of Fleury range, the southeast lines of lots 36, 137 and 138 in Fleury range, the northwest line of lot 294, Des Allonges range, the northeast line of lot 278 of the 5th range opposite Des Allonges range, and the line separating the 5th and 6th ranges; thence, reference being to the official cadastre of the parish of St. Denis, successively, the northeast line of lot 675, the southeast line of the 5th range as far as the southwest line of lot 684, the latter line and the southwest line of lot 664 of the 4th range, the northwest lines of lots 664 and 665, connected on the southwest line of lot 665, the southwest line of lot 473, the broken line bounding on the northwest Territory comprised therein.

the lots 473, 472, 470, 468, 467, 466, 464, 463, 462, 455, 454, 453, 450, 449, 448, 447, 446, 445, 444, 443, 441, 440, and 438; thence, reference being to the official cadastre of the parish of St. Ours, successively by the following lines: the southwest lines of lots 430, 2nd range Sarasteau, and 429, 1st range Sarasteau, the line separating the 1st range Sarasteau from the 2nd range Richelieu, as far as the southwest line of lot 200 of the 2nd range Richelieu, the latter line, the northern lines of lots 200 and 201 of the 2nd range Richelieu connected by a portion of the southwest line of the said lot 201, the southwest line of lot 204 of the 2nd range Richelieu following it northwesterly, the northwest and northeast lines of the same lot, the northwest lines of lots 387 and 386 connected by a portion of the northeast line of lot 387, the northeast line of lot 386, and, lastly, the southeast line of St. Pierre concession to the starting point. The said municipality also comprises all the roads situated along the above described boundaries.

3. All the lots of the official cadastre of the parish of St. Ours, comprised within the boundaries described in section 2 of this act, which do not already form part of the municipality of the parish of St. Bernard, are detached from the municipality of St. Ours and from the electoral district of Richelieu and are annexed to the municipality of the parish of St. Bernard and to the electoral district of St. Hyacinthe, for all electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes.

4. Paragraphs 65 and 74 of the Table of Electoral Districts contained in section 7 of the Territorial Division Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 2), are amended accordingly.
