



## CHAPTER 143

An Act to confirm the limits of the municipalities of the parishes of Varennes and of Repentigny

[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]

**WHEREAS** the corporation of the parish of Varennes Preamble.  
has, by its petition, represented:

That doubts have arisen as to whether Ste. Thérèse Island and the other islands shown in the official cadastre as part of the municipalities of the parishes of Varennes and Repentigny still form part of the territory of such municipalities;

That, in order to avoid any dispute, the corporations of the parishes of Varennes and Repentigny have prayed for the passing of an act decreeing that Ste. Thérèse Island and the other islands mentioned have always, since the incorporation of such municipalities, formed part and do form part, for all purposes, of the territory of such municipalities; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Ste. Thérèse Island and the other islands shown on the official cadastre as forming part of the municipality of the parish of Varennes have always, since the incorporation of such municipality, formed part and do form part, for all purposes, of the territory of the municipality of the parish of Varennes. **2.** The islands shown on the official cadastral plan as forming part of the municipality of the parish of Notre-Dame de l'Assomption de Repentigny have always, since the in- Idem.

corporation of the said municipality, formed part and do form part, for all purposes, of the territory of the municipality of the parish of Notre-Dame de l'Assomption de Repentigny.

Coming into force.      **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
