



CHAPTER 164

An Act to assure the civil effects of the marriage contracted
between Sarsfield Malone and Dame Marie Poliquin

[Assented to, the 11th of April, 1935]

WHEREAS Sarsfield Malone, stevedore, of the city of Preamble.
Three Rivers, has, by his petition, represented:

That, on the 20th of April, 1927, after obtaining dispensation from the first degree of affinity in the collateral line and dispensation from publication of the three marriage banns, he contracted marriage, before the Right Reverend Alfred Comtois, auxiliary Bishop of Three Rivers, with Dame Marie Poliquin, of the city of Three Rivers, widow of the age of majority of Foster Malone, brother of the petitioner;

That the said marriage, contracted in good faith, was preceded by a marriage contract passed on the same day before Mtre. J. A. Lemire, notary public, of Three Rivers, under No. 11900 of the minutes of the said notary;

That the petitioner has prayed that, notwithstanding article 125 of the Civil Code of this Province, the said marriage contract be validated and legalized from the civil standpoint; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The marriage contract between Sarsfield Malone and Dame Marie Poliquin, passed by them before J. A. Lemire, notary public, on the 20th of April, 1927, under No. 11900 of his minutes, is validated, ratified and legalized.
