



CHAPTER 176

An Act to authorize the Corporation of Professional Engineers of Quebec to admit William Robert Caron to practise as professional engineer, after examination

[Assented to, the 2nd of May, 1935]

WHEREAS William Robert Caron, of the city and district of Quebec, has, by his petition, represented: Preamble.

That he is a British subject;

That he is thirty-six years of age;

That he has held a responsible position during the past ten years as electrical superintendent at the Quebec Harbour Commission, under a member of the Corporation of Professional Engineers;

That he graduated in November, 1921, as civil engineering graduate; in January, 1928, as electrical engineering graduate,—International Correspondence Schools; in May, 1932, he passed examinations as junior and associate member of the Engineering Institute of Canada;

That the experience and knowledge he has acquired during the past seventeen years is equivalent to the five years indenture required before passing the examination for admission to practise as member of the Corporation of Professional Engineers;

Whereas the Corporation of Professional Engineers of Quebec have been informed of these facts, together with a list of the studies pursued and positions and experience acquired, and the council of said Corporation has stated that they have no objection to petitioner's request to be allowed to pass the examination for admission to practise and become a member of the Corporation of Professional Engineers without the preliminary five years indenture provided by the Civil Engineers' Act; and

Whereas the petitioner has prayed for the passing of an act for the above purposes and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Admission

1. The Corporation of Professional Engineers of Quebec is authorized to admit William Robert Caron to practise as civil engineer, after having passed the required examinations.

Coming into
