



CHAPTER 5

An Act respecting the contribution by the Government to assure the success of the celebration of the third centenary of the founding of the city of Three Rivers

[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may make a Grant for grant of one hundred thousand dollars to assure the success ^{tercentenary} of the celebration of the third centenary of the founding of the city of Three Rivers, provided that the Government of the Dominion of Canada have appropriated, for the same ^{Proviso.} purpose, an amount equal to that above-mentioned.
- 2.** The payment of the grant authorized by this act ^{Payment of} shall be made by the Provincial Treasurer out of the con- ^{grant.} solidated revenue fund, on the instructions of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.
- 3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
