



CHAPTER 7

An Act to detach certain lots from the parish of St. Ours, in the electoral district of Richelieu, and to annex them to the parish of St. Bernard, in the electoral district of St. Hyacinthe, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The lots known and designated under the numbers 396 to 200 inclusively; and 201 to 204 inclusively, of Sarasto range, of the cadastre for the parish of St. Ours, in the electoral district of Richelieu, are detached from the said electoral district and annexed to the electoral district of St. Hyacinthe, to form part of the municipality of the parish of St. Bernard, for electoral, judicial, municipal and registration purposes. Certain lots detached from parish of St. Ours and annexed to electoral district of St. Hyacinthe.

2. Paragraphs Nos. 65 and 74 of the Table of the Electoral Districts, contained in section 7 of the Territorial Division Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 2), are amended accordingly. Provisions amended.

3. This act shall come into force on such date as it may please the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to fix by proclamation. Coming into force.
