



CHAPTER 18

An Act to amend the Alcoholic Liquor Act respecting closing hours

[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 42 of the Alcoholic Liquor Act (Revised R. S., c. 37, Statutes, 1925, chapter 37), as amended by the acts 16^{s. 42, am.} George V, chapter 21, section 4; 17 George V, chapter 21, section 3; 19 George V, chapter 22, section 2; 20 George V, chapter 32, section 1, and 23 George V, chapter 19, section 1, is again amended by striking out the words: “,and in which and where not more than two stores may be open after six o’clock in the afternoon”, in the sixth, seventh and eighth lines of the third paragraph of subsection 1 thereof, as enacted by the said act 23 George V, chapter 19, section 1.
